**Flight Schedule Pro – Phase II and Help Needed**

BEFA is working to complete our full transition to FSP. Overall the scheduling transition has worked out well. I thank our pilots and staff for their patience. The end result is well worth it. As some of you may have noticed, FSP is actively being developed and improved by the owners. An iPhone app was released earlier this year and has already seen several updates to enable more functionality. There are plans for significant upgrades to it to enable more functions and allow pilots & staff to have all the same functions provided by the website. Speaking of the website, Version 4.0 is currently in beta test and will soon be deployed. The functionality will remain consistent with V3.0 (the current interface) but will offer significant refinements and new features.

**Our next big step is to implement electronic time keeping and maintenance tracking at Renton starting November 1.** We have already done this at PAE at the beginning of 2014 and have had excellent results. Regal Air (our maintenance provider) is very satisfied with it as are our pilots and staff.

A user guide is currently available on BEFA.org on the homepage under the Renton Flight Schedule Pro Users announcement. The new areas pilot should familiarize

themselves with are the "Check AD's and Recurring Maintenance" as well as "Dispatch (Check-Out) an Airplane" and "Check In an Airplane (after return).

We need a few volunteers who can spare a few hours to help us get ready for the November activation. If you can help, or if you have any further questions feel free to contact your CFI, BEFA Staff or myself.

**Safety and Operations Briefing**

**BACKING PLANES INTO THEIR STALLS**

Please remember to place the metal chocks behind the tires when taking the plane out of the stall so that you have a "target" to aim for when pushing it back in on return. We had an incident where a plane was backed into the aircraft parked directly behind it, and this technique aids in preventing that from happening.

**FLIGHT SCHEDULE PRO**

Please note that we have an additional add on to the choices in the "Reservation Type" drop down window on Flight Schedule Pro. "Training" has been added to "Standard". "Training" is to denote a student type training flight in furtherance of an FAA license/rating, (Private, Instrument, Float Rating, Commercial etc...), dual or solo, or a BEFA 6 month check, Mountain Check, Aircraft model/type check, aerobatics etc.... "Standard" means the usual local area flight or Cross Country type flight. Another one that's been added is "Weather", which is used if an aircraft is grounded due to weather, at an airport that is other than its base, and is mostly used by the BEFA Staff. Please work in to your routine,

clicking either "Standard" or "Training" when booking a plane.

As Oliver noted above, we are looking for some volunteers to input some data into FSP in preparation for the November activation. If you could spare a few hours to help, please let me know. Thanks.

**AIRCRAFT COVER SNAPS**

When removing the attach straps on the covers from the plane's wing top, please lift "up" on the snap to disconnect. If you reach up and pull it from the side, causing a side load, it has a tendency to break the receptacle snap in the wing. See Wes for more info. Thanks.
